**TENNESSEE HUMAN TRAFFICKING AND DOMESTIC VIOLENCE TRAINING FOR JUDGES**

The purpose of Tennessee Human Trafficking and Domestic Violence Training is to provide specialized education to judges on the topics of human trafficking and domestic violence. The goal is to hold a 1-2-day training before June 1, 2019. The Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC) will work with state and national partners to identify speakers and create the curriculum. The AOC will strive to train 50 – 100 judges and possibly other court personnel.
